Is your beneficiary information up to date?

You should name a beneficiary for your life insurance, 401(k) and HSA accounts. This ensures that they will distribute the policy proceeds the way you want after your death.

Without beneficiary designations set, in the event of your death, benefits would be paid according to plan rules, which might be different from the designation you would choose.

We encourage you to take a few minutes to review your beneficiary designations, especially after a life event, such as marriage, divorce, birth of a child, etc.

Pitfalls of Not Naming a Beneficiary



Loss of control

Qualified assets no longer pass directly to your optimal heir



Subject to creditors

Assets in your estate are first used to pay off debts



Expense

Probate can cost between 2% and 7% of your estate's value



Tax consequence

Full account balance may be taxed within 5 years
